The health of a newborn is every parent's top priority. When preventable injuries occur due to medical negligence, the consequences can be life-altering. Below is what you need to know.

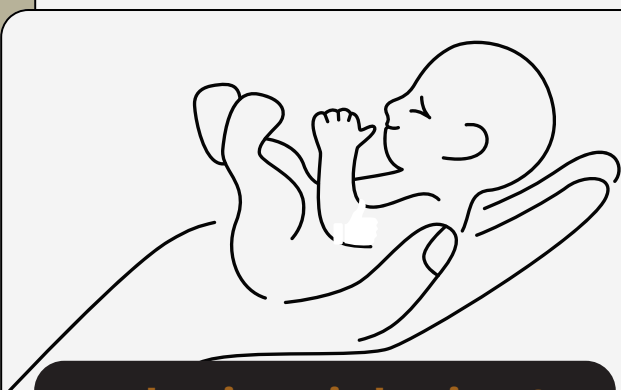
Frequent Causes Of Birth Injury Cases

- C-Section Mistakes



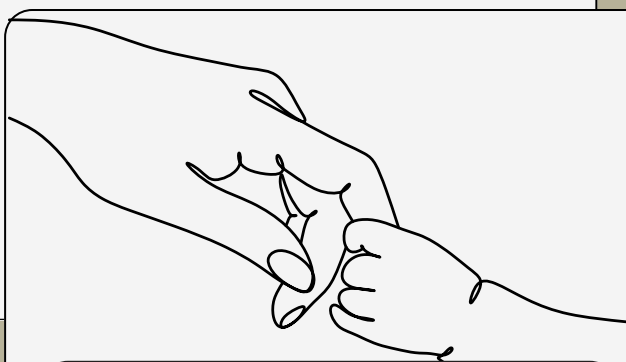
Common Types of Birth Injuries and Birth Trauma
